noun: freedom

- the power or right to act, speak, or think as one wants without hindrance or restraint.
- the state of not being imprisoned or enslaved.
- the state of being physically unrestricted and able to move easily.
- absence of subjection to foreign domination or despotic government.
- the state of not being subject to or affected by (a particular undesirable thing).
- the power of self-determination attributed to the will; the quality of being independent of fate or necessity.
- unrestricted use of something.
- Wikipedia: Freedom, generally, is having the ability to act or change without constraint. Something is "free" if it can change easily and is not constrained in its present state.



noun: snare

- a trap for catching birds or animals, typically one having a noose of wire or cord.
- Trap, net noose a thing likely to lure or tempt someone to harm or error "the wickedness and snares of the Devil"
- Pitfall, trick, trap, tangle, web, mesh, catch, danger, hazard, peril, toils.


BUTTERFLY COCCOON CATERPILLAR




